



Use of Medical Marijuana Policy

Based on Connecticut State regulations 21a-408-1 to 21a-408-70, inclusive, for an Act Concerning the Palliative Use of Marijuana, allows for the controlled use of medical marijuana in the State of Connecticut. Thus, Connecticut citizens may legally obtain a medical marijuana

to possess and or use any form of marijuana on Mitchell College property or at college-sponsored events.

Although, Connecticut law permits the use of medical marijuana, Federal laws outlined by the Controlled Substances Act (CSA) has classified marijuana as a schedule 1 drug which prohibits the use, possession and/or cultivation of cannabis. Therefore, the use, possession, cultivation or sale of marijuana/cannabis in any form violates federal law. Mitchell College must comply with the Drug-Free Communities and Schools Act (DFS6p-6W*10S (F)6772-4 (F83)6 (S 7 -eC-3 (6.1011i; TEQ0 g70
