

Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) Reporting:
Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students
Mitchell College HEERF Student Portion Fund Report

Overview:

CARES, CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

Mitchell College completed and submitted the Funding Certification Agreement on May 15, 2020, with the intention of using 100% of the dedicated Student portion of funding to provide Emergency Grants to students impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

2. The total amount of funds that the institution will receive or has received from the

CARES, CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) grants to students range from \$200 up to \$1,500, awarded based on students with the greatest documented need using Estimated Family Contribution (EFC) from the annual Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). This tiered approach to grant awards provides substantial award amounts to our neediest students as well as emergency grants to all Title IV eligible students who may be struggling as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.
